Camp Rules

- 1) **Hunting, trapping, or interfering in any way with wildlife is not permitted on EPM Property, The only exemptions are the very few folks who were hunting there with the owners permission before the club existed and have grandfathered rights to do so.**
- 2) **During the 4 weekend long, 'camping' shoots each year (Winter Meat Shoot, Spring Shoot, Summer Shoot and Fall Shoot), all modern tents, campers, etc will be set up to the left (south) of the road into the campground. All other camping spots are restricted to period correct (pre 1850) equipment. These shoots are the only time non-members are allowed to camp without specific prior approval.**
- 3) **The Tin Cup rule is in effect for all public shoots.**
- 4) **Firewood is usually available for use in the campground. Members are not permitted to remove firewood for use elsewhere.**
- 5) **No potable water is available or provided. You must bring your own.**
- 6) **There is no trash removal service. If you pack it in, pack it out.**
- 7) **Fire pits may be dug adjacent to the camp. It is IMPERATIVE that you fill in your fire pit when you are through. Any unburned or partially burned wood will be returned to the woodshed. Leaving it in the campground poses hazards to the mowing crews.**
- 8) **Water buckets should be visible outside each tent or lodge.**
- 9) **Please use common sense with fires. They pose a very real hazard during particularly dry periods.**
- 10) **All gates should be left as they were found. In case of an event for multiple people or families, the last vehicle out should close and lock all gates.**
- 11) **Dogs are permitted but should be on a leash and under control at all times.**
